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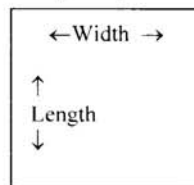

**Rules:**

1. Each entered item must include this completed form. Photocopy this form for each item. Return to: **Audrey Young or Susie Johansson by Feb. 14 @ 5:00PM.**
2. If entering more than one (1) large quilt, (twin size or larger) rank them in order of your preference in case space does not allow hanging of all entered large quilts. You may enter as many smaller quilts or other items as you wish.
3. Only members of Quilters 2 are permitted to enter the show. It must be something you have made, with the exception of antique quilts. You may not have entered it in this show previously.
4. **Entry forms must be received no later than Mon., Feb. 14, 2011 at 5:00 PM. All items must be delivered to the HQ room on Sun., Feb. 27, 4-5 PM.** See Audrey about entering fragile art quilt items.
5. **Each item must be in a separate pillow case.**

## QUILT SHOW GUIDELINES

1. Types of quilts accepted but not limited to: Bed size quilts, wheelchair/lap quilts, wall hangings, table cloths, table runners, placemats, wearable art, bags, art quilts, antique quilts. Quilts, except antiques, must be made by members of Quilters II, and not have been entered in any previous Quilters II show.
2. Deadline for entry forms: **February 14, 2011 at 5PM** to: Audrey Young or Susie Johansson. Please turn them in ASAP prior to that date.
3. Entries: If entering more than one quilt twin size or larger, rank in order of your preference in case space does not allow hanging of all entered large quilts.  
Unlimited number of entries smaller than 48" X 48" per entrant
4. Each entry must have a separate, completed, signed entry form.
5. Delivery of quilts entered in the show:
  - A. **Date of delivery: Sunday, February 27, 2011 - 4 PM - 5 PM, HQ Room**  
Delivery of quilts is on this day ONLY. If you are unable to deliver on this day please make arrangements with someone to deliver the quilts for you.
  - B. Each item must have a provided paper label and your own label on the back.
  - C. Each item must be in a **separate** pillow case or quilt case with provided label, **one item per case**.
  - D. Each item 18" X 18" or larger must have a hanging sleeve of 4" by width of quilt. See instructions below.
  - E. Entries must be clean, no pet hairs, lint, smoking smell. Dirty entries will be refused.
6. Pickup of quilts after the show:
  - A. **February 28, 2011 (Monday) - Ballroom 5PM -6:00PM NO EARLIER/NO LATER**  
If you are unable to pick up your quilts at this time please make arrangements with someone to do it for you. **Make sure that the person picking up your quilt has the claim ticket.**
  - B. **EACH ITEM PICKED UP MUST HAVE A CLAIM CHECK PROVIDED.**

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR QUILT SLEEVE REQUIRED FOR HANGING

### QUILTS OVER 18" IN ANY DIRECTION

The sleeve must be 4" deep when completed. Cut a piece of fabric 8½" deep & as long as the width of the top of the quilt. Turn a 1" hem to the **outside** at each end & machine stitch. Fold the 8½" piece in half lengthwise with end hems to the outside. Sew a ¼" seam along the raw edges, do not turn. Position the sleeve so that the raw edges of the seam are facing the back of the quilt. Whip stitch sleeve to the back of the quilt being careful that your stitches do not go through to the front. The sleeve should be 4" deep, finished. Also anchor back side of sleeve ends to quilt. When your quilt is hung, the rod will go through the sleeve alone & not between the sleeve & the quilt. The rod will not catch because the end hems are on the outside.
