

Stained Glass Quilt class

Objective: To create a stained glass quilt. Additional instructions will include how to create an “Adrienne border” and alternative designs using this quilting technique.

Skill Level Needed: *Confident Beginner*. You know how to thread the sewing machine you will be using, how to wind a bobbin for that machine. You can use a rotary cutter and ruler and are accurate in all your cuts. You can sew an accurate $\frac{1}{4}$ ” seam and have had quilt piecing experience. You understand and have been involved with the following terms and phrases: backing, batting, bias, binding, grainline, scant quarter-inch seam allowance, selvage, WOF (width of fabric).

Supplies Needed: (note: Q2 Sewing Room has some rulers and cutting mats available)

Sewing machine in good working order that you are familiar with using

Thread, Pins, Seam ripper

At least 3 bobbins pre-wound

Rotary Cutter (make sure you have a new or sharp blade)

Rulers and cutting mat (prefer rulers 6” x 24” and 15” square, and prefer 24” square cutting mat)

12 assorted 15” square pieces of fabric (these are your stained-glass pieces)

1 yard of black fabric cut into 1" WOF (this is the leading of the stained-glass and also sashing between the glass pieces).
Fabric for borders and backing
