

## Walk About Quilt

**Instructor:** Carol Hall

**Date:** March 11, 2026

**Time:** 9:00am – 4:00pm

**Skill Level:** This quilt is for beginners to intermediate level.

**Number of students:** Minimum 3 – maximum 10 students.



**Description:** Students will learn basic sewing/quilting techniques. Easy to following instructions and multiple sizes (lap, twin, queen, king). Students will learn how to make Half Square Triangles (HST). Also, instructions for making mitered corners for border fabrics.

**Pattern:** “Walk About” by Ann Lauer, Grizzly Gulch Gallery. pattern download from Connecting Threads - \$11.00. Each student must purchase the pattern.

### **Supplies/Tools:**

Sewing machine (in good working order with manual), construction thread, pins, clips, thread snips, rotary cutter, cutting mat, ruler (10 ½ x 10 ½ or 12 ½ x 12 ½).

See pattern for specifics on fabric amounts needed for the size you choose to make (3 or 4 fabrics). May need additional fabric if fabric is directional or you if chose to fussy cut.

Optional: Iron and pressing mat.
