# From the Editor

Questions have been raised regarding the displayed size of the financial reports.

The financial reports are displayed through the use of an Adobe PDF reader. The pages are created in other software, and converted to the PDF format. This results in certain limitations regarding the size in which the content of the pages can be printed. HOWEVER, the size of data displayed can be made larger or smaller using the "Zoom" feature of the reader.

Just click on the Magnifier symbol on the tool bar, then click on the page. Each time you click on the page, the data display will become larger. If you right click the mouse, a menu will open which will permit you to select any magnification of the original from 25% to 800%.
