DO YOU WANT TO MAKE PERFECT HALF SQUARE TRIANGLES AND QUARTER SQUARE TRIANGLES!!!

There is a computer software package that will allow you to do just this. You can make any size half square or quarter square triangles never having to leave the house. This computer software lets you choose your finished size block, print out the necessary pattern on regular computer paper, pin the pattern onto your fabric, sew on the dotted lines and cut on the solid lines. When finished you will have many completed blocks.

This is a program that I purchased at the Tucson Quilt Show a couple of years ago and, if you make many of this type of block, I think you would be pleased with the outcome. It can be found at bearpawproductions.com for the price of \$27.95.
